Young/Adult Volunteers

We are always looking for volunteers to support our social skills group by being the extra eyes for the therapists. Our college volunteers act like peers, but also help with setting up, cleaning after sessions. We would be delighted to have someone help send email reminders, home work to parents, do some generic photographic work, filing lessons, copying lessons, helping with setting up fieldtrip. Occasionally we stage special events and workshops, and volunteers can get involved before during and after these events with everything from helping us with entertainment to set up, take down and writing thank you notes.

Minimum requirements:
